Introduction

The Woodland lifestyle acoustic system is a high-performance sound insulation solution that consists of two main components:

Phonestar TRI, a recycled paper board with high density mass.

Wolf Decoupling plate, a rigid board.

The system can be installed in wet or dry areas, depending on the choice of waterproofing and adhesive products.

Recommendation

Based on the information provided by the client, we recommend the following products and installation methods for the Woodland lifestyle acoustic system:

- Adhesive to bond Phonestar to the correctly prepared substrate: <u>ARDEX</u>
 <u>AF 180</u>, a high-performance, low-odour, solvent-free adhesive that offers
 excellent initial grab and long working time.
- Adhesive to bond decoupling plate to Phonestar: ARDEX AF 180, for the same reasons as above.
- Waterproofing membrane to surface of decoupling plate <u>ARDEX WPM</u>
 <u>155R</u> or <u>ARDEX WPM 002</u>, both rapid-drying, flexible, and crack-bridging membranes that provide superior water and vapour resistance.
- Tile Adhesive to decoupling plate (no waterproofing, for dry areas):
 ARDEX X77
 , a high-yield, fibre-reinforced, non-slip tile adhesive that offers extended open time and pot life.
- Tile Adhesive to bond to ARDEX waterproofing (for wet areas): <u>ARDEX X18</u>, a high-performance, polymer-modified, flexible tile adhesive that is compatible with ARDEX waterproofing membranes and offers excellent adhesion and coverage.
- Grout: <u>ARDEX FG8</u> or <u>ARDEX FSDD</u> + <u>Grout Booster</u>, both high-quality, polymer-modified, cement-based grouts that are easy to apply and clean, and offer a range of colours to suit the design.
- Silicone: <u>ARDEX ST</u> or <u>ARDEX SE</u>, both neutral-curing, mould-resistant, and colour-matched silicones that provide a professional finish and seal the joints and perimeters.

Engineered Timber System Overlay (Dry Areas Only)

- Adhesive to bond Phonestar to the correctly prepared substrate: <u>ARDEX</u>
 <u>AF 460</u>, a solvent free, low-odour, MS Polymer based adhesive with good open and working times.
- Adhesive to bond decoupling plate to Phonestar: ARDEX AF 460, for the same reasons as above.
- Adhesive to bond engineer timber to the decoupling plate ARDEX AF 460

Important Notes

It is important to note that working with concrete based substrates, these are checked as per the flooring standard NZS 1884: 2013 for moisture content (less than 75% RH) and pH level. If the substrate is not within the acceptable range, ARDEX shall be consulted for appropriate recommendations.

It is also important to note that working with timber based substrates, these are checked for compliance with NZS 3604, the standard for timber-framed buildings. The timber should be properly graded, treated, and fixed, and the moisture content should not exceed 18%. If the substrate does not meet the requirements of NZS 3604, appropriate remedial actions should be taken before applying the adhesive.

It is also important to follow the manufacturer's instructions and recommendations for each product, including the mixing, application, curing, and storage conditions. The products should be used within their shelf life and expiry date, and stored in a cool and dry place.

The Woodland lifestyle acoustic system should be installed by qualified and experienced installers, who have the necessary tools and equipment, and follow the relevant industry standards and codes of practice. The system should be inspected and tested for sound insulation performance after installation, and any defects or issues should be reported and rectified promptly.

Waterproofing shall only be carried out by professionals whom have completed the relevant training with ARDEX NZ and hold current certification.
